Dear church,

When I came on board as the pastor a year ago, I came at the prompting of the Holy Spirit. God made it truly clear to me that this is where we were to serve. When I came, I immediately came up with a list of items that we as a church needed to address from a safety and appearance standpoint as the two go together. There were a lot of what I thought were simple fixes that in turn lead to some major issues. I thought I would share with you the list I presented to the property committee when I first arrived, how far we have come, and what is currently in the works.

Pillars of the Social Hall – in process.

Concrete Parking stones either painted or replaced. - Currently pricing.

Carport above the ramp facing the parsonage looks terrible and neglected. - Done

Lights for the playground. – Done

Lights between the buildings. – Done

Lights for in front of the church. – Done

Emergency lights and fire alarm system fixed and operational. – in process.

Lock on glass door to office repaired. – Done

Church sign and signage – in process

Broken door closure on glass door to office – Done

Repaint ceiling of the sanctuary where it is peeling off. – in process.

On top of everything on this list, let me share with you what has also been done. Paid-off loan to new education building. Repaired sheetrock in Social Hall. Repaired leaks in wall of Social Hall. Painted the Social Hall. Replaced the roof on the Social Hall. Replaced old outdated sound system with all new sound system. Fenced in the entire back of the church property so that we can host community sports. Added to the playground. Repaired three separate leaks in the parsonage which called the ceiling to open up on the first floor of the house in three different places. Repaired the ceiling in those three places. Repaired wall that had come lose at the parsonage in mud room. Replaced the front fence of the parsonage as my children were being approached by questionable people often. It was for their safety and well-being. Adding shutters to Social Hall parlor.

Other than ongoing projects we also are raising money to:

Paint the new educational building to make it more family friendly and inviting.

Next on the agenda is addressing the windows of the two-story education building and then the building itself, as we cannot continue to neglect it. We actually need of the space.

I put this out there to keep everyone abreast of what is happening at the church and to be totally transparent and good stewards of God's monies and His church.


